The Saudi Journal of Medical Insights (SJMI) is a peer-reviewed journal committed to publishing high-quality, clinically relevant, and original medical research. Please follow the guidelines below to ensure a smooth submission and review process.

1. Types of Submissions

SJMI welcomes the following types of submissions:

- Original Research Articles
- Systematic Reviews
- Clinical Case Reports
- Brief Communications
- Commentaries
- Psychiatry & Mental Health Studies
- Public Health and Epidemiology Reports

2. Manuscript Formatting

All manuscripts must be submitted in Microsoft Word (.docx) format. Please use the following formatting:

- Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt
- Line spacing: Double
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- Include page numbers at the bottom center of each page

3. Manuscript Structure

Submissions should include the following sections where applicable:

- Title Page (with authorship and affiliations)
- Abstract (250 words max)
- Keywords (3–6 keywords)
- Introduction
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- References (Vancouver style)

4. Referencing Style

Use the Vancouver referencing style. References should be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are cited in the text.

5. Submission Process

Ensure your manuscript is anonymized for double-blind peer review.

6. Peer Review Policy

SJMI uses a double-blind peer review process involving at least two independent reviewers. All manuscripts are reviewed for originality, scientific validity, and relevance to the journal's scope.

7. Publication Ethics

SJMI adheres to COPE guidelines. Authors must avoid plagiarism, redundant submissions, and must disclose conflicts of interest. Ethical approval must be obtained for clinical studies.
